Junior Achievement of Central Carolinas' volunteer-delivered, kindergarten-12th grade programs foster work-readiness, entrepreneurship and financial literacy skills, and use experiential learning to inspire students in our community to dream big and reach their potential. Junior Achievement of Central Carolinas proposed a mobile app, designed to track Junior Achievement student data and allow for follow up and engagement of participants after programming.

Mental Health America of Central Carolinas

Mental Health America of Central Carolinas provides mental health education and advocacy, and suicide prevention in the Charlotte area. They proposed acquiring technical assistance to make modifications to their current customized Salesforce database or the creation/purchase of a new database to have a succinct way of capturing the data related to the information and referral calls that Mental Health America of Central Carolinas receives.






